## PRESENTATION TOPICS:

1. ***“Present & Compare Two Aspects of Technology, e.g. multimedia, social platforms, virtual reality, audio-visual, software, etc.”***
2. ***“Select a system (pref. within the communications domain or in any domain) and present its features, function and possible applications.”***

ALTERNATIVELY

***“Select a branch of engineering and/or a job in engineering OTHER THAN the ones discussed in class and present it.”***

3. ***“Present a relatively new (and preferably pioneer) aspect of Multimedia, OTHER THAN those which comprise part of the course material in the related unit.”***

ALTERNATIVELY

***“Select a branch of Engineering and/or a Job in Engineering OTHER THAN the ones discussed in class and present it.”***

- Note 1: an on-screen presentation is imperative
- Note 2: students can have the main points of their presentation in **note form** (e.g. bullets), but NO text is allowed (it would be advisable to present the same notes/main points on screen). Also, students should use THEIR OWN WORDS in communicating information from the sources consulted.
- Note 3: the students who deliver a presentation are expected to explain to their audience in plain English any difficult word or specialized term they may use!
- Note 4: the sources should also be mentioned
